This statement concerns Three D Metals, Inc. and its Division Williams Metals and Welding Alloys current status with compliance to the "Conflict Minerals Rule" which was issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission on August 22, 2012 as directed by Section 1502 of the Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act of 2010. The law defines conflict minerals as certain minerals originating from the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) or adjoining countries.

Three D Metals, Inc. is committed to purchasing only raw materials that meets the regulations of Section 1502 and not to source "Conflict Minerals" that finance armed conflicts and human rights abuses.

Three D Metals, Inc. maintains due diligence in assuring that its raw material are sourced only from suppliers that fully meet the requirements of Section 1502, and requests its supply base to fully support the due diligence efforts.
