Conflict Minerals Statement

Conflict Minerals are those minerals mined in areas of the world where there are armed conflict and human rights violations. Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act and its implementing regulations (the “Act”) implement disclosure requirements for certain publicly traded companies which purchase or use Conflict Minerals.

While Three D Metals, Inc. is not subject to Section 1502 of the Act, we are committed to purchasing only raw materials that meet the regulations of Section 1502 and not to source “Conflict Minerals” that finance armed conflicts and human rights abuses.

Three D Metals, Inc. maintains due diligence in assuring that its raw materials are sourced only from suppliers that fully meet the requirements of Section 1502 and requests its supply base to fully support the due diligence efforts.
