## RoHS Compliance Statement

### Three D Metals, Inc.

The RoHS Directive (the “Directive”) restricts the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. The Directive is understood to include the following maximum limits (by weight in homogeneous material):

• Lead (Pb)*	0.1%
• Cadmium (Cd)	0.01%
• Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI)+	0.1%
• Mercury (Hg)	0.1%
• Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)	0.1%
• Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)	0.1%
• Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)	0.1%
• Butyl Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP)	0.1%
• Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)	0.1%
• Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)	0.1%

\* except for leaded copper alloys up to 4.0% as exempted in the Directive.

+ non Cr VI material may be available on coated products and must be requested at time of inquiry to determine availability before placement of actual order.

Our material does not exceed these maximums.
