



THREE D METALS

STATEMENT ON TOXIC SUBSTANCES CONTROL ACT (TSCA)

To whom it may concern:

As needed, Three D Metals, Inc. (“Three D” or the “Company”) purchases electrical-grade aluminum and copper from international suppliers. In accordance with the requirements of the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA), 15 U.S.C. §2601 et seq., and EPA regulations at 40 CFR §707.20, Three D hereby provides certification regarding imported materials consisting of electrical-grade aluminum and copper.

These materials are imported in the form of coil, bar, and other shapes used in manufacturing and distribution. Based on their physical form and function, these products meet the definition of an “article” as set forth in 40 CFR §711.3, in that they:

1. Have a specific shape or design;
2. Their end-use function is dependent in whole or in part upon that shape or design; and
3. Do not release a chemical substance under normal conditions of processing or use.

Accordingly, these imported materials are considered articles under TSCA and are exempt from Chemical Data Reporting (CDR) and other manufacturing-related requirements.

However, as required by regulation, Three D certifies that all chemical substances comply with applicable rules or orders under TSCA and that the Company is not offering a chemical substance for entry in violation of TSCA or any applicable rule or order thereunder.

This certification applies to all shipments of electrical-grade aluminum and copper articles imported by Three D Metals for distribution or further processing within the United States.
